BOTH STICKERS MUST USED.

The sign must contain the words and symbols in bold exactly as stated. NO DEVIATIONS. Additional wording may be used to enhance the sign, in addition to the 2 stickers.

2) The Judge will judge the sign where it has been sited, by the Club and will complete their judging on Rally Day.











- 3) The sign must be made of weatherproof material.
- 4) The size of the sign must be no less than 1 metre by 1 metre and no more than 3 metres by 3 metres.
- 5) The sign is to be erected in a prominent position but shall not be placed on a highway or a roadside verge.
- The sign shall remain in place until Wednesday, 5th June 2024, when it will then be taken down by the individual Clubs and brought to the Rally to be on display for the public.

EQUIPMENT

Music is allowed and the PA technician will be responsible for playing all the mp3's. Members can also bring music on their phone to go into an aux system. Iphone 7 and above- please bring adapter. Make sure the music is downloaded in case there is no phone signal.

NOTES

Radnor YFC will provide a table and chairs – competitors can bring their own costumes, props etc. No set will be allowed.

TIME

30 minutes preparation time. 3 minutes will be allowed for the live news report. 2 minutes will be allowed for stage preparation prior to the live broadcast.

Any late entry will result in a deduction of ten points per day.

TEAM

TASK

Team of 2 members to cook a two-course meal set by the judge. Members will be given a list of ingredients, on Monday 3rd June 2024, that they must purchase and bring with them on the day of the Rally. The judge will provide the method/recipe on the day for members to follow. One dish will be savoury, and one will be











sweet.

EQUIPMENT

Two (2) butane gas stoves (currently available from camping and outdoor retailers/Argos/Amazon). The stoves **MUST** be like the images below and be fuelled by butane cartridges.





- Radnor YFC members are only permitted to use butane gas stoves, examples have been shown.
- Battery operated equipment such as a mixer, liquidiser, etc. are allowed.
- For health & safety reasons the Chief Cookery steward will inspect each stove to check that the gas cylinders are correctly fitted and if the competing members are young they may ask an older member of the club or parent to adjust the cylinder if necessary.
- Clubs NO LONGER need to provide receipts.

PLEASE NOTE: Clubs MUST provide their own alcove for display (68.5cm x 68.5cm x 61 cm) this will not be provided by County.

DISPLAY

Meal to be displayed in an alcove (68.5cm x 68.5cm x 61cm high) (backing material and accessories may be arranged by the competitors prior to the commencement of the one hour and will be outside of this time). All exhibits to be within the alcove size\space including any drapes or lining, in\on serving dishes\containers (competitors to supply). Accessories that are in harmony with the rest of the exhibit and that are in scale with it and each other, but not dominant, are allowed.

TIME

One hour for cooking, to include displaying of meal in the alcove that the competitor provides (68.5cm x 68.5cm x 61cm high)

Should teams not finish within the hour for cooking (additional 15 minutes for questionnaire), 1 point per minute will be deducted from the overall score.
