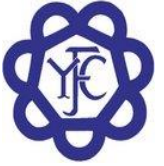

1)	<b>Apologies</b> These were recorded in the attendance book.
2)	<b>Minutes</b> The minutes of 6 <sup>th</sup> September 2023 were read and signed as a correct, this was proposed by Mark Nixon, Edw Valley YFC and seconded by Ella Harris, Teme Valley YFC.
3)	<b>Matters Arising</b> There were no matters arising.
4)	<b>Correspondence</b> There was no correspondence.
5)	<b>To review AGM Trip Cardiff</b> The trip was very successful and those who attended really enjoyed themselves. The food at the Severn Arms was tasty and the portions were generous. Next time members would like more pickup stops enroute for people to get on the bus e.g. The Groe, Erwood etc.
6)	<b>Cheltenham Races</b> A 52 seaters bus is booked to Cheltenham Races. Ella suggested having breakfast at the Severn Arms, Penybont before the bus departs. Members agreed this was a good idea, so Ella was to sort. Agreed that the Office will collect all money before hand (£45 per member / £50 per non-member).
7)	<b>Christmas Mystery Tour – Hereford</b> Members agreed that a trip to Hereford would not be a ‘mystery’. It was suggested to organise a bus to Montgomeryshire Christmas Jumper Dance in Newtown between Christmas and New Year. Office to find potatoes boxes (15+) for Bar & Stage. Agreed to have the top 3 from the Pool and Darts competition play and represent the current members providing they are over the age of 18.
9)	<b>Pool &amp; Darts Competition</b> Saturday 9 <sup>th</sup> December at Rhosgoch Golf Club. 6pm start. Adam to look at rules and ensure a draw is done prior to the competition.
