## <u>'TIME TO SHINE' COMPETITION (28 and under)</u> <u>12th February – 17<sup>th</sup> February 2024 at the Albert Hall, Llandrindod Wells</u>

This Competition is to be held in conjunction with the Drama Competition but adjudicated separately.

## <u>RULES</u>

Clubs are allowed to enter an unlimited number of teams in the 'Time to Shine' Competition (28 yrs and under), but members can only compete in one 'Time to Shine' and one 'One Plus'.

## ELIGIBILITY

A team shall consist of a minimum of one member and a maximum of 6 members, each of whom must be 28 years of age on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023 and full members of a club affiliated to Radnor YFC.

## DRAW FOR ORDER OF COMPETING -

Entry form must be submitted to the County office by <u>Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2024</u>. A draw for order of competing will be made on <u>Tuesday</u> <u>2<sup>nd</sup> January</u> at the Competitions meeting. If Clubs are not able to compete on certain evenings due to extreme reasons this must be made apparent before the draw is made.

<u>WITHDRAWING</u> after the closing date, and the order of appearance made; on no account are clubs allowed to withdraw, or the order of appearance changed.

<u>Finals Night</u> ~ This will take place on Saturday 17th February 2024, when the first three teams will be required to perform. These teams will have already been adjudicated on their first performance earlier in the competition.

Live musical accompaniment may be used but accompanists will have to be part of the team of 6 members. Radnor YFC will provide a max of 6 headsets or handheld mics.

(Clubs may enter members in the "One Plus", 'Time to Shine' and Entertainment Competition, but the same material cannot be used).

<u>Object</u>	To promote members' interest and involvement in the presentation and development of the visual arts, e.g. MUSIC, DANCE, THEATRE, RECITATION, COMEDY REVIEWS.	
<u>Requirement</u>	A minimum of one member, and maximum of G members, to present visual art/s in good taste and suitable for a theatre audience. Material of a questionable nature will be penalised. <b>Teams are reminded that they will be performing to a family</b> audience.	
<u>Time allowed</u>	Not to exceed 6 minutes including the setting and the clearing of the stage. Penalties: Up to 15 seconds overtime – 2 penalty marks; Up to 30 seconds overtime – 5 penalty marks; And a further 5 penalty marks will be deducted for every 15 seconds thereafter.	
Space allowed	Maximum area – in front of main curtain.
